Establish your home nest with Anker Bak's Rocking Nest Chair, from **Carl Hansen & Son**, the inspiration for which was the designer's sister who was seeking a practical piece of furniture to rest and relax in with her newborn. Available in oak or walnut combined with stainless or powder-coated steel. carlhansen.com

2. Cast light with the Claw table lamp by **Charles Edwards**. The lighting element is inspired by a French design dating from the 1900s. The mobility of the ball at its base enables the arm to be moved in any direction. Available in a range of metal, paint, or combination finishes. charlesedwards.com

3. This French Louis XVI-style grouping of two winged cherubs was designed by Antoine Durenne (1822-1895) and is signed by its maker. While this version is found at **Cedric Dupont Antiques**, the same cast can be seen at Fontaine Saint-Genès in Clermont-Ferrand in France. cedricdupontantiques.com

4. The Xanthippi bedside table, made of solid oak polished with a water-based varnish, is a graceful touch of nature in your bedroom or as a side table in your living room. Available in two sizes at **Coco-Mat**, which can also be combined as a set. The furnishing was conceived by Greek designer Giorgos Kyriazis. coco-mat.com

5. The Royal Crown Derby deck-mounted tub-shower mixer from **Samuel Heath** is a unique collaboration by two of the world's most celebrated designers and manufacturers. The brassware is hand finished and hand molded. samuel-heath.com

6. The right object can transform a garden or a room. One such statement is a wood or aluminum sphere with its complementing pedestal, from **Accents of France**, a California-based company. The sculptural sphere, with its suggestions of longitudes and latitudes, is available in custom colors. accentsoffrance.com

7. The Puppy Outdoor Relaxing Chair invigorates your open-air area with a fresh design that is sleek and comfortable. Made of wicker, with a powder-coated black-matte aluminum frame, and Sunbrella fabric cushion. Available at **Teak Warehouse**. teakwarehouse.com

8. Inlaid bone is the most natural of all materials. Its texture and hue are imperfect, but in a rather perfect sense. The Ecliptic pedestal table from **Aidan Gray** is defined by a vibrant white and black pattern, the result of being inlaid with resin. aidangrayhome.com

9. It's the best of combinations—a respect for design, coupled with a respect for the environment. Fil Doux Textiles teamed up with designer **Clodagh** to create the Nomad Collection of woven and printed cotton-blend textiles. clodagh.com

10. The Augustine metal garden bench by **Thomas O'Brien for Century** emanates a classic elegance. The scrolling neo-classical motif references organic forms found in a well-tailored garden. centuryfurniture.com

11. Even when they are unlit, this pair of "Sunburst" ceramic table lamps by Georges Pelletier lights up a room. The white-and-gold glazed lamps, circa 1970, are signed by the Belgian-born artist. The items are in very good vintage condition, a fortunate discovery by **Serge Castella Interiors**. sergecastella.com

12. The Sag Harbor lounge chair is **Sutherland's** interpretation of a 1950s Francis Mair chair. It's aluminum frame transforms it into a fluid and svelte form, completed with a woven wrap. Available in natural, stained or black. sutherlandfurniture.com

13. Define any transitional space in your home with the Hart side table by Gabby. The textured black metal frame is topped with a slab of elegant white marble. The design is clean and the table can assume multiple functions throughout the house. Available at **Lam Bespoke**. lambespoke.com

14. The talented furniture maker and designer **Keith Fritz** brings a bit of old Hollywood glamour into the home with his String of Pearls mirror. It takes its place in a room like the star item it's meant to be. Available in all woods and finishes, with gold or silver leaf. keithfritz.com

15. Designer Annie Eadie first envisioned the **Heveningham Collection** in 1990 and her furnishings and beds are now featured in the world's most coveted private homes, palaces, and renowned hotels. Her zinc-coated beds come in standard black, dark green, gunmetal, and white. heveningham.co.uk
