
## LIFE-ENHANCING DESIGN

have shaped her wildly successful and extensive career. The text covers her design philosophy—a firm believer in the tenets of integrative medicine, Clodagh embraces both ancient and cutting-edge methods in an effort to comfort not only the body but also the soul. Clodagh incorporates such modalities as Chromotherapy and biophilia into her distinctive projects.

Some of Clodagh's award-winning commercial and residential projects covered in the book include Miraval Resort and Spa in Tucson, Arizona, W Hotels, Six Senses Douro Valley Resort and Spa, East Hotel in Miami, and apartment complexes such as The Caledonia,



Abington House and Citizen 360, to name just a few. One of her most recent projects, Six Senses Kaplankaya, located on the Aegean coast in Turkey, was recently named by *Condé Nast Traveler* as “the hottest spot

in Turkey.” Clodagh also just announced her latest project with Grand Hyatt on the Cayman Islands, slated to open in 2020.

Entering a Clodagh-designed space is an experience of both serenity and indulgence. She believes that clutter undermines serenity, but minimalism should not be self-denying, and she balances these principles with her signature style, described as “Life-Enhancing Minimalism.”
